COUNTY OPERATIONS ON DECEMBER 22-23, 2020

**WHEREAS**, on March 17, 2020 Upshur County issued a Declaration of Local Disaster which Declaration of Local Disaster was continued indefinitely by order of the Commissioners Court dated March 23, 2020, pursuant to the provisions contained within Section 418 et. seq. of the Texas Government Code; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the opinion of the undersigned that due to the recent COVID-19 spike and the increasing number of county employees being absent from work due to COVID-19 infections that the Upshur County Justice Center and the Upshur County Courthouse shall be closed to the public on December 22, 2020 and December 23, 2020, with operations resuming on Monday, December 28, 2020 at 9:00 a.m.

**IT IS, THEREFORE RESOLVED, ORDERED and DIRECTED** that the Upshur County Justice Center and the Upshur County Courthouse shall both be closed to the public on December 22, 2020 and December 23, 2020; and **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that any department heads of Upshur County, Texas, whether located in either of said buildings or not, be and they are hereby authorized to furlough from work any or all department personnel from

reporting to work on said days, which shall be in the absolute discretion of each county department head.

**EXCEPTIONS:**

1) Each Upshur County office, department or facility may be required to work the above said days by order of the Upshur County District Judge, Upshur County Judge or any particular county department head as to his or her office or department.
